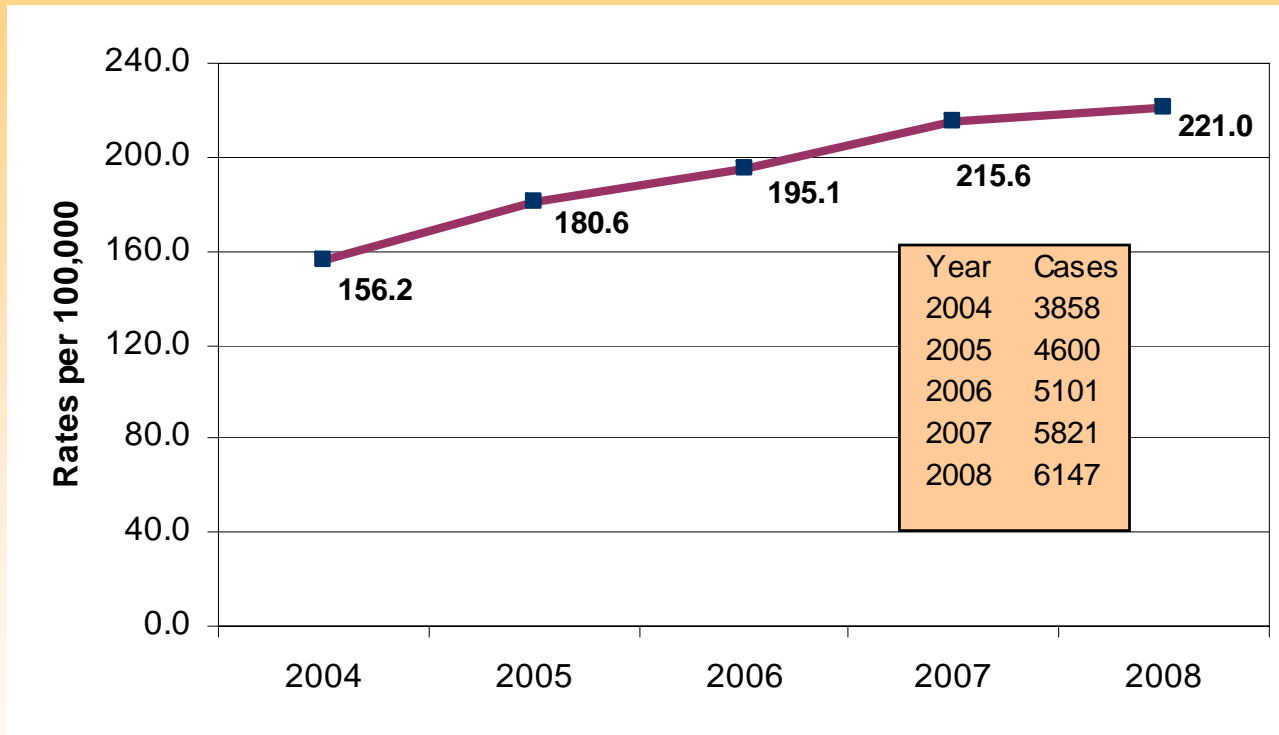

# Chlamydia

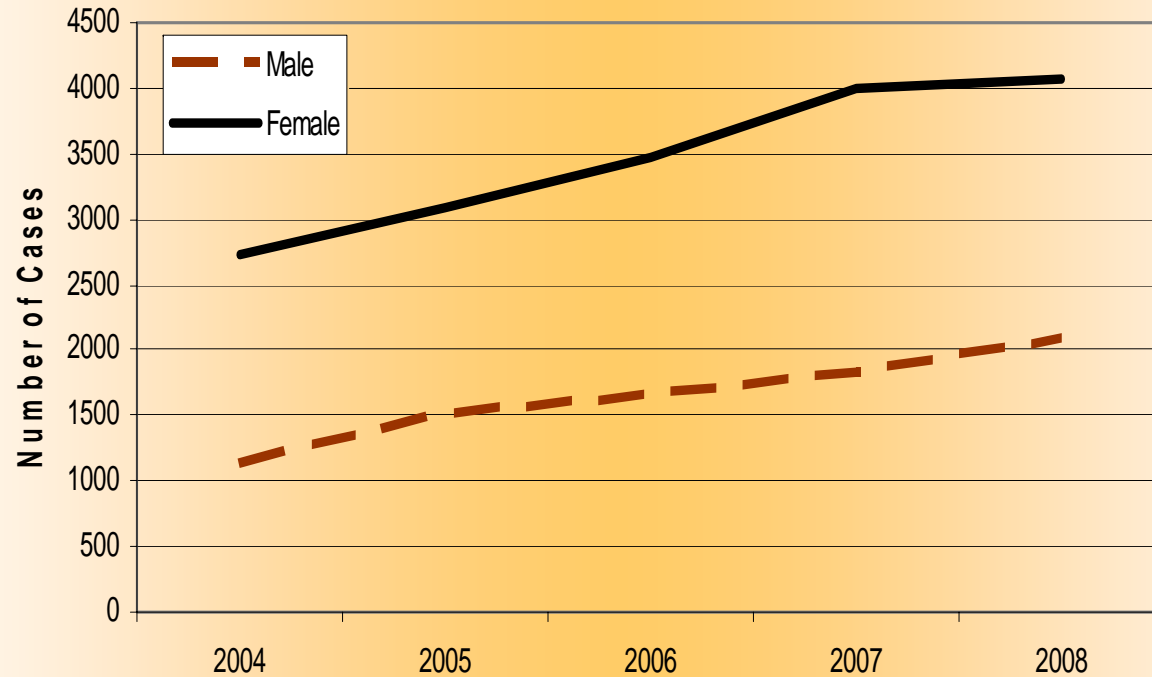
**2008 Reported Cases (6,147)**

## **Chlamydia Incidence Utah 2008**

**Of the 6,147 persons with chlamydia:**

- **66% were Female (4,062)**
- **34% were Male (2,085)**
  
- **29% were age 15-19 (1,805)**
- **37% were age 20-24 (2,273)**
- **18% were age of 25-29 (1,115)**

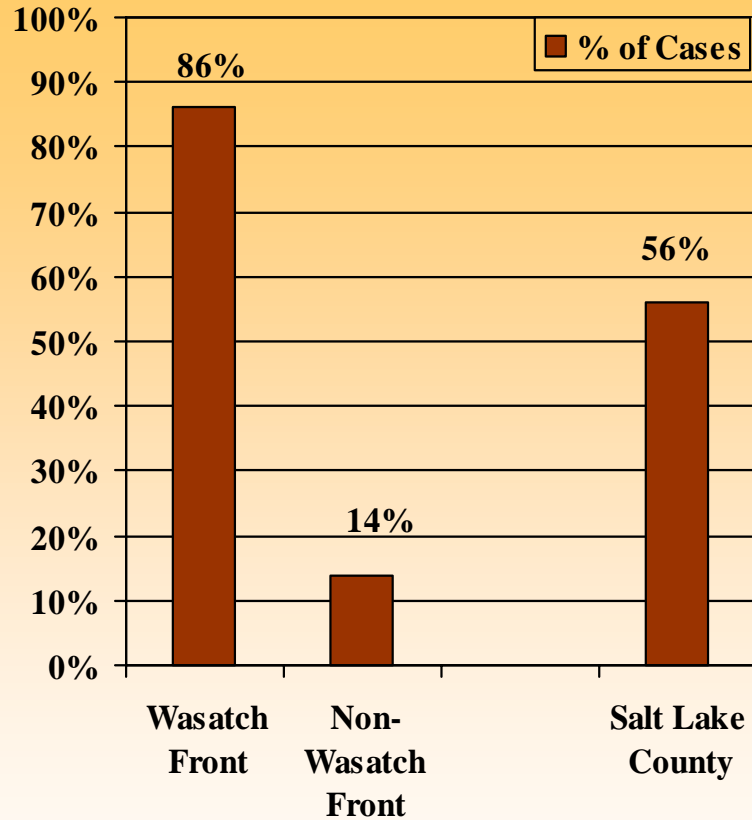


## Chlamydia Incidence Gender/Ethnicity Utah 2008

Race/Ethnicity	Male	Female
White	68%	66%
Hispanic	23%	25%
Asian/Pacific Islander	3%	4%
Black	5%	3%
Native American/Alaska Native	1%	2%

Ethnic minorities comprise 18% of Utah's population yet make up **33%** of those newly diagnosed with chlamydia in 2008.

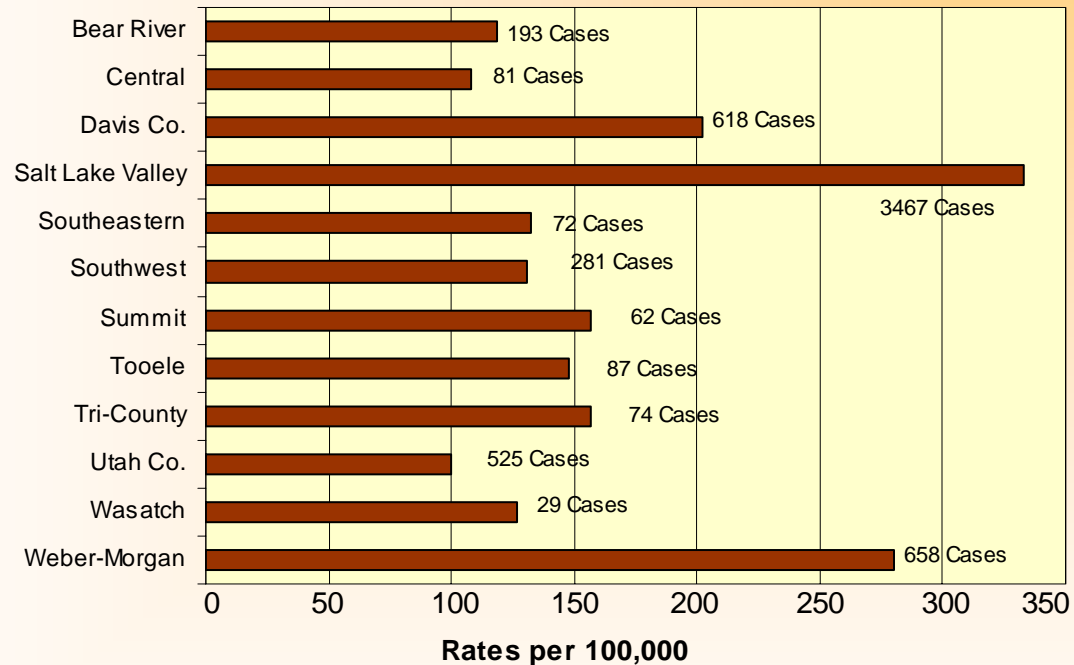
# Chlamydia by Residence at Diagnosis Utah 2008
