When you arrive in Utah, you will get a special Medicaid card that can be used in the first month after arrival.

This booklet lists the Urgent Care Centers and Hospital Emergency Rooms that can be used during your first month after arrival from:

After your first month in Utah, you will get a new list of Urgent Care Centers and Hospital Emergency Rooms from the medical plan you have picked.

When you get your new Medicaid card with a plan printed on it, you must use the Urgent Care Centers or Hospital Emergency Rooms listed on the new medical plan.

If you use an Urgent Care Center or Hospital Emergency Room *not* listed on your medical plan, **you will have to pay the bill.**

USING EMERGENCY ROOMS

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

If you or one of your family members is very sick or your life is in danger:

- Call 911 or go to the closest Emergency Room.
- Ask a neighbor or apartment manager to help you.
- Even if it is the weekend/holiday, you can go to a Hospital Emergency Room.
- Call your caseworker right away. Your caseworker speaks your language and will be able to help you.

Some emergencies are:

- Chest pains
- Trouble breathing
- Bleeding that can not be stopped
- Severe allergic reactions
- Loss of consciousness
- Broken bones
- Poisoning
- Shock
- Seizures

USING URGENT CARE CENTERS

- * Use Urgent Care Centers if you need to see a doctor now but the problem is not life threatening.
- * Call your caseworker and tell him/her of your medical need. Your caseworker speaks your language and can help you with your medical care.

Some urgent medical needs are:

- Severe vomiting
- High fever
- Sore throat
- Cuts that need stitches
- Burns that are not life threatening
- Sprains and some kinds of broken bones
