CHIP Re-opens Enrollment

- What:** Utah's Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) is re-opening enrollment to Utah children, 18 years old and under.
- Why:** The Utah Legislature has appropriated \$4 million additional funds to provide health insurance to an average of 47,000 children. Currently, CHIP insures 26,658 children statewide.
- Who:** All Utah children who meet the following requirements may apply:
- 18 years old and under
 - U.S. citizens or legal residents
 - Not covered by other health insurance
 - Meet income guidelines (i.e. a family of 4 with a maximum income of \$41,300 per year)
- When:** Monday, July 2, 2007
