Targeted HIV Testing

Persons at very high risk for HIV qualify for this service. Those most at risk are men who have sex with men, injection drug users, and men who have sex with men and Inject drugs. Hispanic and African American men and women who engaging in vaginal and anal sex without a condom are infected at higher rates than non-Hispanic men and women who engage in vaginal and anal sex without a condom.
