The purpose of the Utah Ryan White Part B (URWB) Community Advisory Committee (CAC) is to provide advice to the staff and senior management of the Utah Ryan White Part B Program and to work collaboratively on a range of strategies, policies and programmatic issues impacting the lives of people living with and/or affected by HIV/AIDS. The CAC works with URWB to improve the health and quality of life of Utahans living with HIV.

The Utah Ryan White Part B (URWB) Community Advisory Committee (CAC) is accepting applications for membership. In accordance with its bylaws, “The committee shall be comprised of people living with HIV, loved ones of those living with HIV, and community advocates.” In addition, the CAC seeks to have as diverse a membership as possible so that the perspectives of all PLWHA in Utah are represented. Although URWB values our community partners, contractors of URWB and their Board members/employees/interns are ineligible to be CAC members.

The process of recruiting new members is ongoing until the CAC reaches a maximum of 8 members. **Everyone must complete and submit an application.** Applications are accepted by mail, email and fax.

Meetings of the CAC take place Quarterly on the following dates in 2017, 4/13, 7/13, and 10/12 from 6:00PM to 8:00PM in Salt Lake City. CAC members are expected to attend all scheduled meetings, and to participate on committees or working groups.

All applicants must complete the attached form. Applicants are selected on the basis of their own skills, experience and interests. Also, the URWB program will strive to achieve a balanced representation of the demographic and geographic profile of the epidemic in Utah.

Applicants will be contacted to arrange an interview, by phone or in person, with URWB Co-Chair. This meeting will give applicants an opportunity to provide additional information about them, ask questions, and receive more information about the CAC.
