

## ICD-10 Overview




- **ICD-10**—International Classification of Diseases 10<sup>th</sup> Revision, Clinical Modification (CM) and Procedure Coding System (PCS).
- All HIPAA covered entities that submit, pay or process claims are required to implement ICD-10 coding on October 1, 2015.
  - ICD-10.CM (Diagnosis Codes)
    - Increases from 3-5 digits in ICD-9 to 3-7 digits in ICD-10
    - Increases from 13,000 codes in ICD-9 to approximately 68,000 codes in ICD-10

**Example:**  
 ICD-9: Clavicle fracture, closed, unspecified part, ICD-9 Code = 810.00  
 ICD-10: Clavicle fracture, closed, unspecified part, right side, initial encounter  
 ICD-10 Code = S42.001A
  - ICD-10.PCS (Surgical Procedure Codes)
    - Increases from 3-4 numeric in ICD-9 to 7 alphanumeric in ICD-10
    - Increases from 4,000 codes in ICD-9 to approximately 72,000 codes in ICD-10

- Internal Testing: March 2015-June 2015
- External Testing: July 2015-September 2015
  - Providers
  - UHIN
  - Managed Care Organizations
  - Tested with Vendors
- Results: Good test results; a few minor issues have been identified and fixed but our system is processing and adjudicating claims as expected.
- Our goal is to make the transition to ICD-10 as seamless as possible
