



Tooele County Health District




Comparison of Trends Between Utah State and Tooele County Health District's Birth Rate for Women Age 15-19, 1989-1997




Percent of Live Births to Unmarried Women by Maternal Age, Tooele County Health District, Utah, 1989-1997




Comparison of Live Births Between Hispanic and Non Hispanic Mothers by Maternal Age, Tooele County Health District, Utah, 1989-1997




Trimester of Entrance into Prenatal Care by Mother's Age, Tooele County Health District, 1989-1997




Preterm Births by Maternal Age, Tooele County Health District, 1989-1997
