Fees Increasing for Utah Vital Records

Fees have held steady since 2003

(Salt Lake City, UT) – In order to implement Utah’s Fiscal Year Appropriations Act, House Bill 2, beginning July 1, 2009, the fee schedule for services provided by all state and local vital records offices in Utah will change.

This act provides for the support and operation of state government for fiscal year 2010. The new fee schedule increases the cost for some copies, abstracts and vital records searches. The schedule below lists the services affected by the fee increase, which goes into effect July 1, 2009:

1. Issuing a **certified birth abstract** or **voluntary declaration of paternity** or verifying any of the same information:
 - **\$18.00** for the first copy, abstract or verification
 - **\$8.00** for each additional copy of the same record.
2. Issuing a certified copy of a **certificate of still birth**, or verifying any of the same information:
 - **\$15.00** for the first copy, abstract or verification
 - **\$8.00** for each additional copy of the same record.
3. Issuing a certified copy of a **death or fetal death certificate** or verifying any of the same information:
 - **\$16.00** for the first copy or verification of the information
 - **\$8.00** for each copy of the same record.
4. Issuing a **certified burial transit permit**:
 - **\$7.00** for each copy.
