

Dental Benefits for CHIP

The following benefits are for children who have **CHIP**.

Benefits with a \$0 co-pay:

- Routine exams, cleanings (2 per year), topical fluoride, x-rays

Benefits with a co-pay*:

Basic Services:

CHIP A - \$0

CHIP B - 5% of approved amount

CHIP C - 20% of approved amount after deductible

Basic services include fillings, extractions, oral surgery, etc.

Major Services and Specialist Services:

CHIP A - 5% of approved amount

CHIP B - 5% of approved amount

CHIP C - 50% of approved amount after deductible

Major services include crowns, bridges, dentures, etc. Specialists include endodontists, periodontists, oral surgeons, prosthodontists, etc.

Reminders:

- If you cannot pay your co-pay, please help the dentist by canceling your appointment the day before.
- You must go to a dentist who is enrolled in your dental plan's network, either Premier Access or DentaQuest. Make sure you ask which dental plan your dentist accepts.
- Remember to take your CHIP dental ID card to each appointment.

*American Indians/Alaska Natives do not pay co-pays.

Finding a Medicaid Dentist

If you already have a dentist who takes your dental benefit and sees you regularly, stay with that dentist. He or she knows you and has a history of giving you care. Your dentist must be a Medicaid provider. Please take your current Medicaid card to all appointments.

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Dental Benefits Summary for Medicaid Clients

Medicaid offers dental benefits to children, until age 21 and pregnant women:

You may have the following care at no charge to you:

- Check-ups, including x-rays and a cleaning every six months
- Resin (tooth colored fillings) for front teeth and some limited small fillings on back teeth
- Silver amalgam fillings for back teeth.
- Root canal treatment for certain teeth**
- Pulpotomies for infected baby teeth
- Extraction (pulling) of teeth
- Dentures, partial dentures**
- Space maintainers for children with missing teeth
- Some orthodontic care for children**
- Some specialty care or surgical centers for care under general anesthesia**
- Emergency exams for problems such as pain

**Some services have special rules, limits or need prior approval. For more details, talk to your dentist.

If you are pregnant, getting your teeth cleaned in the 22nd to 26th week of pregnancy, can help you have a full term pregnancy.

Family Dental Plan accepts MEDICAID, CHIP and PCN

FDP will still provide dental services for those who no longer have dental coverage through Medicaid. The services will be within the Medicaid scope of service and the patient must pay for the services according to the Medicaid reimbursement rates. Payment must be made at the time of service by cash or check with the proper identification.

Dental Benefit Summary for Primary Care Network

The following benefits are available for adults who are eligible for **PCN**.

You may have the following care with a 10% per procedure co-payment:

- Check-ups with x-rays and cleaning every six months
- Resin (tooth-colored) fillings for front teeth
- Silver amalgam fillings for back teeth
- Extraction (pulling) of teeth
- Emergency examination for treatment of problems such as toothache

Ask your provider for an estimated cost for each visit. Expect that the cost will be typically between \$5 and \$15 per visit. The cost will depend on the type and amount of work that you need.

If you are on PCN, you must go to a dentist who is a Medicaid provider. Please take your current eligibility card to each dental visit to show you have benefits.

Does your child need fluoride drops or pills? Ask your child's medical or dental provider.
