Due to an incident in Lebanon, MO in which an infant passed away due to the bacteria Cronobacter Sakazakii, who was being fed Enfamil Premium Newborn, Wal-Mart is temporarily removing the 12.5 oz can (lot # ZP1K7G) from their shelves.

Mead Johnson states that the lot was tested for Cronobacter Sakazakii and was negative upon leaving the manufacturer plant. The infant's death is still under investigation and no recall has taken place.

Enfamil Premium Newborn is not a vouchered product. Utah WIC orders this product from Infusion Innovations. Infusion Innovations has informed us that they do have this lot number, which may have been delivered to your clinic.

Please contact all WIC participants on this product to inform them of the situation. If a participant has an infant on this product, it would be the parent's/guardian's discretion on whether to continue giving this formula.

If an infant is on this formula and is experiencing any adverse reactions the parents should call their physician and Mead Johnson to report.
