**ANNUAL STATE APPLICATION FOR FUNDS UNDER IDEA PART C  
OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

The Utah Department of Health offers an opportunity for review of the 2022 Annual Application for Funds under Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). The application is available to view February 24, 2022 to April 24, 2022. Public comment is invited from February 11 to March 24, 2022.

This application for funds includes the required assurances and the budget for federal funds. The amounts listed in the budget are based on the projected allocation year FFY2022 received from the Office of Special Education Programs in the United States Department of Education. A copy of the application will also be sent to each early intervention agency contracted through the Utah Department of Health, as well as the Utah Parent Center.
