Parent Infant Program  
For the Deaf and Hard of Hearing

## Parent Infant Program- PIP

- ❖ Listening/Speaking and ASL goals and assessments
- ❖ Regular visits to work on goals
- ❖ Other services such as toddler groups, Deaf mentors, ASL classes, and Listening Time

## Both

- ❖ Attend IFSP meetings
- ❖ Assess at least every 6 months

## Early Intervention Program

- ❖ Service Coordinator runs IFSP meetings
- ❖ May provide additional services such as physical therapy, nursing, etc.
- ❖ Owns the child's Early Intervention record/file
