# Title V State Sexual Risk Avoidance Education - Nicole Bissonette & Elizabeth Gerke (handout)

- FY2021 federal grant for October 2021 through September 2022.
- Recent legislation has approved 100% allocation of funds and the new funding amount is \$442,775.
- Application process will remain the same as in past years.
- Distribution will be 75% to locals and 25% reserved at the state level
- There is a Federally determined amount required in the travel budget to involve the 3 local partners required to attend an annual meeting.
- Additional funding is reserved for training certifications to benefit local areas.

  - 0.50 FTE Assistant Project Coordinator (\$29,888)

# **Early Childhood Comprehensive Systems: Health Integration Prenatal-to-Three Program** - Nicole Bissonette & Elizabeth Gerke

- This is a competitive grant application for \$255,000.
- The purpose of this grant is to build integrated maternal and early childhood systems of care that are equitable, sustainable, comprehensive, and inclusive of the health system, and that promote early developmental health and family well-being.
- The primary responsibility of this grant is to coordinate the Early Childhood Utah Advisory Council as well as developmental screenings.
- Home visits have been funded in the past however, there is not funding available this period.
- Required minimum 1 FTE and a family leader.

## National and State Tobacco Control Program Continuation - Braden Ainsworth & Christal Dent (Handout)

- \$1,256,406 continuation application for year two of a five-year CDC grant cycle due January 29, 2021.
- Local health departments will be funded at the same amount as year one.
- The \$45,000 increase will be used to fund a to be determined Community-Based Disparities Agency or organization per CDC grant requirement.
- Component One will be used for contracts.
- Component Two is strictly for cessation and quit learning. Pass through funds are not permitted.
- Component One Summary \$1,181,506:

  - Community-Based Disparities Agency \$45,000
  - UDOH Tobacco Program \$516,505.60
