Uninsured Parents Urged to Apply for Health Coverage *Primary Care Network opens enrollment today*

- What:** Utah's Primary Care Network (PCN) will open enrollment for parents today, May 10 through May 24. PCN is a primary preventive health coverage plan for uninsured adults. Benefits include physician services, prescriptions, dental services, eye exams, emergency room visits, birth control, and general preventive services.
- Why:** Since April 2009, PCN has been closed for enrollment and has not accepted new applications. Beginning today through May 24, Utah parents may apply online, by mail, or in person to receive primary health care.
- Who:** Parents who meet the following requirements may apply:
- Have dependent children under age 19 living at home
 - Age 19 through 64
 - U.S. citizens or legal residents
 - Not covered by other health insurance
 - Meet income guidelines (e.g., a family of 4 with a maximum income of \$33,075 per year)
 - Not qualified for Medicaid
 - Have no access to student health insurance, Medicare or Veterans benefits
